Role & Responsibilities

We are looking for an experienced senior or principal front end developer (~10 years industry experience) to join our team on a three month contract with the possibility of an extension at the end of the initial term. The role will primarily involve auditing our small code base and suggesting refinements; planning and estimating front-end tasks for the product roadmap; designing and implementing explainable AI features of a chatbot; and collaborating on hiring a permanent senior front end developer.

Flexible working two days per week, you will be expected to attend meetings at our office in Cambridge once every 2 or 3 weeks. There will be some mentoring through pair programming and code reviews.

Skills & Experience

The ideal candidate will have:

- Computer Science or STEM degree
- Proficiency in Vue.js; Auth0; Vitest; Playwright; jsdom; Vuetify
- Experience of component/integration/e2e testing web interfaces
- Previous involvement interviewing senior front end engineers
- Experience or understanding of chatbot design
- Knowledge of messaging software architectures (for scaling chatbot systems)
